Teamster Pension Fund. Those loans were used to fund numerous hotels/casinos and other businesses in various parts of North America including Cuba, the Dominican Republic, and in Las Vegas. In truth, half the hotels/casinos in Las Vegas would never have been built without the financial support of Hoffa's IBT. Unfortunately for Hoffa, his brusque and dictatorial ways eventually made him unpalatable for the Mafia bosses, who were used to being treated with the utmost respect. The Mafioso's nickname for Hoffa was "Marteduzzo," which is Sicilian for "The Little Hammer," because he ruthlessly hammered away at anyone who displeased him, or got in his way on his rise to power. But as Hoffa's disrespect for the Mafia bosses increased, the "Little Hammer," inevitably transformed himself into the lowly nail destined to be banged into oblivion.
